- Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1954 as the 630th Engineer Company
- Inactivated 15 March 1956 in Korea
- Activated 21 June 1963 at Fort Chafee, Arkansas
- Inactivated 28 August 1971 in Vietnam
- Activated 16 September 1980 in Germany
- Inactivated 15 August 1988 in Germany
